It is very simple; listen and follow the rules. If you have any questions, please ask the Pageant Chairman anytime before the pageant or at the contestant meeting. Please be professional and on time. This pageant isn't going to wait on you! And most of all, have fun and enjoy yourselves.

1- This is going to be a very fast paced pageant. As soon as you are done with your first category, you need to be back stage changing into your next category. There will only be 2 guest spots (approx. 8 minutes) between each category.

2- Please pick your dresser wisely. This person will help you do everything. There is little room backstage so preplan what you're going to do.

3- This pageant is not going to wait on you! If you miss your call time, you will be scratched. NO EXCUSE. Consider this your warning.

4- Dressing area: The Center has limited electric plug-ins. So, we need to get creative when it comes to using electrical outlets. Please be sure to bring with you a multi outlet extension cord and a lighted mirror. Some parts of the dressing area is very dark. Please plan ahead!

5- I will be giving everyone a general lineup at Friday's early evening meeting at The Center Friday, April 18, 2007, at 6:00 p.m. We cannot post all of our curtain call times because we **will** keep this pageant moving as fast as possible. Just remember, the first curtain call will start at 8:30 p.m. We will take it from there! Please preplan all of your steps and dress changes, makeup and hair. Please get organized, be professional and Good Luck!
